School facilities should be made available for community use as much as is practical without hindering education needs and use.

In all instances, public school educational programs and activities shall have priority use of school facilities. School facilities may be used at other times when not required for school purposes.

Requests for use of school facilities shall be made to the building principal. Rental fees may be charged in accordance with state law. The rental rates shall be established by the Board of Education.

Any individual or group using school facilities shall be required to abide by all facility use regulations.
