# Summer School 2026

## Frederic School District



Register your student using the grade they will be entering in the fall. Please DO NOT register unless your student is committed to attending the full week. There is a waiting list for attendance.

### Breakfast and Lunch

We will be serving breakfast and lunch to all students attending summer school at **no cost!**

### Transportation

Bus pick-up and drop-off from home is available from June 15th to July 2nd. If your student requires busing, please inform the Elementary Office as soon as possible. Your bus driver will communicate transportation times shortly before the session begins on June 15th, 2026.

### Attendance

Please ensure your student attends all registered courses.

Students on a waiting list will replace a registered student who does not attend on the first day.

### After School Plans

Please inform the office of your student's default afternoon plans or any daily changes.

This ensures a safe and smooth transition to the correct location.

### Course Fees

Some of our course offerings do require a fee. Please submit all payments to the Frederic Elementary School or pay via Infinite Campus under the "Fees" section.

### Course Enrollment

Courses are registered on a first-come, first-served basis and are capped between 18 and 25 students. The course will become unavailable if the maximum registration is met.

### Out of District Students

Families who do not live in the Frederic School District, or who are not currently open enrolled at the Frederic School District, will be charged \$75 per student, per week to attend Summer School.

A maximum amount of \$225 per week will be charged per family. Additional course fees still apply. Frederic students will receive priority access when registering for Summer School courses.

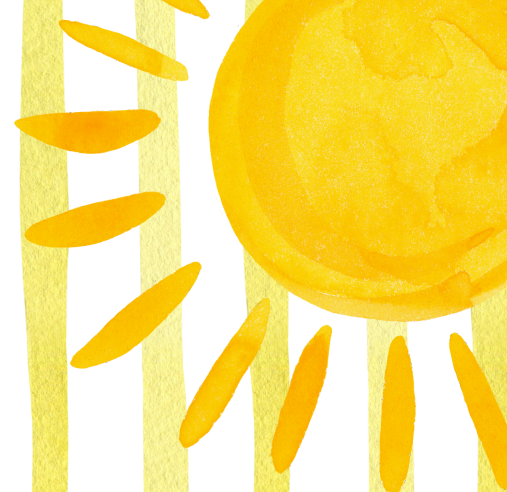

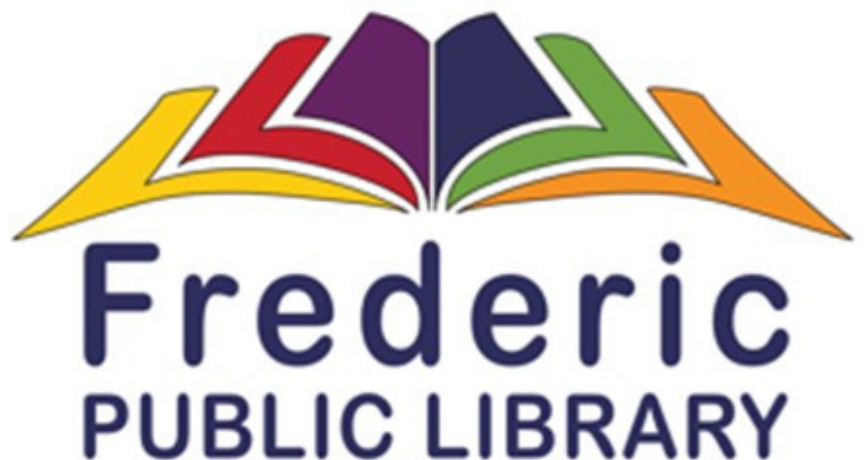

# JUNIOR LIFEGUARDING

## SWIMMING COURSE

Recommended for students ages 11-14, who have passed American Red Cross Level 4 swimming lessons.

The Junior Lifeguarding Course is to build a foundation of knowledge and skill for future lifeguards. Participants are not required to master or perfectly execute the skills, but learn techniques and build stamina. The course does not certify participants in lifeguarding, first aid, CPR or AED use.

### 30 HOUR COURSE:

July 6th - 10th from 7:50am - 1:00pm

July 13th - 17th from 7:50am - 1:00pm

Prerequisites to enter Junior Lifeguarding is as follows:

- Swim the front crawl for 25 yards continuously while breathing to the front or side
- Swim the breaststroke for 25 yards continuously while using a pull, breathe, kick, and glide sequence.

Students will complete the Water Competency Sequence:

- Step into the water and fully submerge.
- Maintain position for one minute by treading water, floating, or a combination of the two.
- Rotate one full turn and orient to the exit.
- Level off and swim on the front or back 25 yards.
- Exit without using a ladder or steps.

All swimming classes are delivered from the Learn To Swim Program by the American Red Cross and taught by certified Water Safety instructors. Parents/Guardians must drop off and pick up from the Elementary School. School bus transportation is only provided to and from Unity pool.

<b>PRE-LEVEL 1</b>	<b>AGE 4-5</b>	<i>Classes take place in the kiddie pool with progression to the big pool. Swimmers will work on entering and exiting the pool independently, submerging mouth and blowing bubbles, front and back gliding with assistance, and combining arm and leg motions on the front and back with assistance.</i>
<b>LEVEL 1 INTRO TO WATER SKILLS</b>	<b>AGE 5 &amp; UP</b>	<i>Basic swim and safety skills will be performed with assistance in the big pool. Swimmers will work on bobbing, retrieving submerged objects, front and back glides, combined and simultaneous arm and leg actions on the front and back with assistance.</i>
<b>LEVEL 2 FUNDAMENTAL AQUATIC SKILLS</b>	<b>AGE 6 &amp; UP</b>	<i>Basic swim and safety skills will be performed without assistance in the big pool. Swimmers will work on submerging, front and back glides, combined, alternating, and simultaneous arm and leg actions on the front and back without assistance. Swimmers must perform the exit skill of swimming on the front for 5 body lengths, rolling to their back, floating for 15 seconds, rolling to their front, and then continuing swimming for 5 body lengths to move onto level 3.</i>
<b>LEVEL 3 STROKE DEVELOPMENT</b>	<b>AGE 7 &amp; UP OR COMPLETION OF LEVEL 2</b>	<i>Swimmers will focus on flutter, scissor, breaststroke, and dolphin kicks. They will focus on increasing their distances of the Front Crawl, Elementary backstroke, and Back Crawl. Introduction to diving.</i>
<b>LEVEL 4 STROKE IMPROVEMENT</b>	<b>SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF LEVEL 3</b>	<i>Swimmer should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 25 yards. Swimmers will work on rotary breathing, freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, scissor kicks, side strokes, whip kicks, breast strokes, treading water with modified scissor kicks, and diving from a kneeled position.</i>
<b>LEVEL 5 STROKE REFINEMENT</b>	<b>SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF LEVEL 4</b>	<i>Swimmer should already be able to: swim freestyle, breast stroke and backstroke 25 yards, scissor kick, ship kick, tread water, and dive. Swimmers will work on: alternate breathing, stride jump, refinement of all stroke, kick, and turn skills. Feet-first diving skill introduction and treading water refinement.</i>
<b>LEVEL 6 SKILL PROFICIENCY</b>	<b>SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF LEVEL 5</b>	<i>Swimmer should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 50 yards, back stroke, breast stroke, and butterfly 25 yards, sidestroke 10 yards, tread water for 3 minutes, and dive. Swimmers will work on: all six strokes, front and back crawl flip turn, stroke turns, pike and tuck surface dives, pike and tuck dive from the board, tread water for 5 minutes, and basic water rescue.</i>

All classes are led by the Learn To Swim Program through the American Red Cross and taught by certified Water Safety Instructors.

There will be a **\$30 fee** to participate in Swimming Lessons.
